- 84-inch Treated Water Pipeline from Leonard Water Treatment Plant to Highway 5 Pump Station
- Leonard Water Treatment Plant Power Substation/Transmission Line

Note: - Also Serves counties: Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Fannin, Hunt, Kaufman, Rains, and Rockwall.

- NTMWD is a Regional Wholesale provider of Potable Water. The residential water bill and household income have been estimated for the City of Plano, NTMWD's largest wholesale customer, based on information from the City of Plano's website, Texas Municipal League and the U.S. Census Bureau.

- Public Water System ID numbers: Wylie PWS - # 0430044, Tawakoni PWS - # 1290052, Bonham PWS - # 0740051, Future Leonard/ North WTP - #NA.

- NTMWD plans to receive the USACE Clean Water Act Section 404 Permit in January 2018. In June 2015, NTMWD received the TCEQ Water Rights Permit for the Lower Bois d'Arc Creek Reservoir.
